**Start Talking: Use the conversation starter below or create your own!**

**Key Scripture: Read the following together.**

*“Then Jesus cried out and said, ‘He who believes in Me, believes not in Me but in Him who sent Me. 45 And he who sees Me sees Him who sent Me. 46 I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness. 47 And if anyone hears My words and does not believe, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world. 48 He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him—the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day. 49 For I have not spoken on My own authority; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak. 50 And I know that His command is everlasting life. Therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak.’” John 12:44-50*

1. What does this scripture tell me about me?
2. What does this scripture tell me about God?

**Start Sharing: Choose a question (or several) to create openness and discussion.**

- How can we demonstrate God’s grace and mercy to others? What can we expect when we reflect His goodness toward others?
- Read John 8:2-11. What does this show us about Jesus’ heart towards people? If Jesus’ starting point is not to bring judgment to others — how should that impact how we treat others?

**Start Praying: Pray together and for one another.**

*“Father, we thank you for being a good God who is gracious and merciful. Lord, open our eyes to just how deep and wide your love for us is. We ask that you would help us to treat others with the same grace and mercy as you have already demonstrated to us. As we do, we ask that they too would see your goodness in and through us. In Jesus’ name, amen!”*
