Key Scripture: Read the following together.

“One thing I have desired of the Lord, that will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in His temple... 8 When You said, “Seek My face,” My heart said to You, “Your face, Lord, I will seek.” Psalm 27:4, 8

1. What does this scripture tell me about me?
2. What does this scripture tell me about God?

Start Sharing: Choose a question (or several) to create openness and discussion.

- What are some ways, according to Scripture, that we are able to enter into God’s presence? How can we fight against distractions from being in His presence?
- Why is it important that we spend time with God? What happens when we do spend time with Him?
- Read Luke 5:15-16 and Mark 1:35. What can we learn from Jesus in regards to spending time with the Father?
