

Kingdom Come: “Jesus, the Sound of Jubilee”

Start Talking: Use the conversation starter below or create your own!

- Share a highlight from the past week. What is something that made you smile?

Key Scripture: Read the following together.

“And [Jesus] was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: 18 “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; 19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.”

1. What does this scripture tell me about me?
2. What does this scripture tell me about God?

Start Sharing: Choose a question (or several) to create openness and discussion.

- Jesus not only announced why He came in Luke 4 — He also demonstrated these things throughout His earthly ministry (and He is still doing them to this day)! Share a time with the group when you experienced Jesus in one of these ways.
- When Jesus made these declarations, it shifted the atmosphere, and people experienced God for the first time in 10 generations. What is one way you believe Jesus wants to reveal Himself to you today? How do you think Jesus wants to reveal Himself to others through you?

Start Praying: Pray together and for one another.

“Father, we thank You you came to bring restoration and healing to our life. We ask that You would continue to reveal Yourself to us, and that Your kingdom purposes would be done.
