Start Talking: Use the conversation starter below or create your own!

- Share a highlight from the past week. What is something that made you smile?

Key Scripture: Read the following together. *“Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.”*

Hebrews 10:19-23 ESV

2. What does this scripture tell me about God?

Start Sharing: Choose a question (or several) to create openness and discussion.

- Describe a time when you experienced God’s presence. How did it change you?
- What does it mean to have a “true heart” as we draw near to Him? How can we have a heart that is ready to receive from God?
- What is something that holds you back from coming to Jesus confidently? How can we pray together in that regard?
