Start Talking: Use the conversation starter below or create your own!

- Share a highlight from the past week. What is something that made you smile?

Key Scripture: Read the following together. *“And the Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” And let him who hears say, “Come!” And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely.” Revelation 22:17*

1. What does this scripture tell me about me?
2. What does this scripture tell me about God?

Start Sharing: Choose a question (or several) to create openness and discussion.

- What is it about “hearing” that causes us to call out to the Lord to “come?”
- Why is it important that we grow in our love and compassion for others? Why is it important for us to call on the Lord?
- Read Luke 14:16-23. Why is it important that we compel others to come to Jesus? What does that look like?

Start Praying: Pray together and for one another.

“Father, we come to you in the name of the Lord Jesus. We need you to strengthen us and to guide us. We want to do your will. We say to your Lord Jesus, “Come!” Put a stop to the wickedness, the death, the murder, the abuse, the trafficking... come! Lord, empower us and strengthen us to reach unbelievers, to compel them, to influence them, to set an urgency for them to come to you. People need you, help us to bring them in. In Jesus’ name, amen!”
