

“Walkin In The New Life In Christ”

Start Talking: Share about your week with others. What’s going well? What’s something we can be praying together about?

Key Scripture: Read the following together. *16 Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer. 17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. 2 Corinthians 5:16-17 NKJV*

1. What does this scripture tell me about me?
2. What does this scripture tell me about God?

Start Sharing: Choose a question (or several) to create openness and discussion.

- How do we handle skepticism and rejection from those who knew us before our transformation in Christ? How do we distinguish between the world's perspectives and the truth of who God says we are as new creations in Christ? In what ways can we be bold and speak confidently about the work that Christ is doing in us, despite intimidation or doubt? How can we find support and guidance from others in our spiritual journey?
- How can we combat the temptation to revert back to our old ways and truly live in the newness of Christ? How did Jesus respond to doubt and temptation during His time in the wilderness, and what can we learn from His example? What scriptures do you use to combat lies and temptations from the enemy?
- How can we recognize and resist the temptation to believe lies that the enemy tries to use to draw us back into our old ways? How important is it to consistently seek God's truth through His word as we walk in our new identity in Christ? What practical steps can we take to live out the reality of being a new creation and walking in the truth of who God says we are?

Start Praying: Pray together and for one another.

“Father, help us to walk in the new life you have provided daily. We ask for your help to help us see the world how you see them, and not according to the flesh. We cling to Your Word today and ask for Your truth to radiate from our innermost being. We are reliant on You to overcome temptation and live in the new life and freedom you have given. We love you Lord, Amen.”
